CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

The above consignor ("Consignor") and Wags to Riches agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. All net profits of Wags to Riches benefit United Coalition for Animals (UCAN), a non-profit, 501(c)(3) charitable organization that operates a low-cost spay/neuter clinic.
2. Wags to Riches will accept merchandise for consignment on the days and during the hours posted on its website, which may be changed at any time by Wags to Riches. Consignor is responsible for having the items clean and ready for resale. If, with Wags to Riches' consent, Consignor leaves items for consignment to be evaluated by Wags to Riches at a date later than when Consignor drops them off, Wags to Riches will notify Consignor of any items that will not be accepted. Consignor will pick up unaccepted items within 5 days after notification or the items will be deemed donated.
3. Wags to Riches has the right to determine the selling price for all items in its sole discretion, based upon what Wags to Riches believes customers will pay for the item. Wags to Riches retains the right to increase or decrease the selling price at any time without prior notice to the Consignor, including coupon redemption, sales and scheduled reductions. *Any items that cannot initially be priced at \$15 or more will be treated as a donation.*
4. Upon sale of an item, Wags to Riches shall retain 50% of the net selling price, which excludes sales tax and handling fees. Handling fees include bank and credit card expenses and necessary additional surcharges for moving, cleaning or repairs. The Consignor will receive 50% of the net selling price upon sale. The 50% retained by Wags to Riches is considered a charitable donation and is tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.
5. The consignment period for merchandise other than jewelry is a maximum of 60 days and the consignment for jewelry is 120 days (as applicable, the "Consignment Period"). Consignor has the right to reclaim any unsold items at any time during the Consignment Period. At the end of the Consignment Period, merchandise priced at \$15 or under will be deemed to be donated. Unless Consignor agrees to automatically donate unsold items, for any items unsold at the end of the Consignment Period that are priced over \$15, Wags to Riches will notify the Consignor and Consignor may elect to either donate the merchandise or pick it up within 5 days of such notification. *After 5 days, any merchandise not picked up will be deemed donated.*
6. Consignor checks are available for pick-up at Wags to Riches after the 10th of each month for merchandise sold during the previous month. Checks not cashed within 90 days of issue are automatically voided and considered a donation. *It is the responsibility of the Consignor to pick up the check.* When possible, Wags to Riches will notify Consignors when checks are available for pick-up. Checks can be mailed to Consignors who provide self-addressed, stamped envelopes for this purpose. Check Stubs serve as the Consignor's receipt for tax deductions.
7. Wags to Riches provides insurance for loss due to fire, theft, or other casualty during the time consigned merchandise is in its possession. The insurance carries a \$500.00 deductible. Any item priced at \$500 or less is consigned at the consignor's own risk. In case of loss of an item priced over \$500 on the day of the loss, Consignor will be reimbursed 100% of the insurance amount paid which exceeds \$500.00. Wags to Riches strongly recommends that Consignor maintain personal insurance coverage on all merchandise consigned with Wags to Riches. Wags to Riches is not responsible for any loss resulting from damage to the merchandise before it enters or after it leaves the possession of Wags to Riches.
